Admission to newly created specialized schools in the system of the Agency of Presidential Educational Institutions, entrance exam results PRESS RELEASE

August 17 this year a press conference was held on the results of admission and entrance examinations to the newly created specialized schools in the Agency's system. It was attended by employees of the Agency of Presidential Educational Institutions and the Ministry of Public Education.

Reception of documents for the 2022/2023 academic year in the newly created specialized schools was carried out online from June 1 to June 30 through the website ariza.piima.uz. More than 300,000 students have applied to study at these schools.

From what grade is admission to specialized schools?

Of the 168 specialized schools transferred to the system of the Agency of Presidential Educational Institutions in the 2022-2023 academic year, the following recruitment was carried out:

- in the direction of exact sciences: for grades 5-11

- in the direction of natural sciences: for grades 7-11.

These schools and boarding schools offer examinations in the following subjects:

IN THE DIRECTION OF THE EXACT SCIENCES: Mathematics, English for grades 5 and 6:

25 math questions, 5 of which will be logical thinking questions. For each correct answer, 3.1 points are awarded, for a total of 77.5 points.

In English - 15 questions, 2.1 points for each correct answer, for a total of 31.5 points.

In total, a maximum of 109 points are awarded in mathematics and English.

For grades 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 in mathematics, physics, English:

20 math questions are provided, 5 of which will be logical thinking questions. For each correct answer, 3.1 points will be awarded, for a total of 62 points.

Physics - 10 questions. In total, 3.1 points are awarded for each correct answer, for a total of 31 points.

In English - 10 questions, in total for each correct answer 1.1 points are awarded, in the amount of 31 points.

In mathematics, physics and English, a maximum of 104 points is awarded.

IN THE DIRECTION OF NATURAL SCIENCES:

Biology and English for Grade 7:

25 biology questions, 5 of which will be logical thinking questions. For each correct answer, 3.1 points are awarded, for a total of 77.5 points.

In English - 15 questions, 2.1 points for each correct answer, for a total of 31.5 points.

In total, a maximum of 109 points are awarded in biology and English.

For grades 8, 9, 10, 11 in biology, chemistry and English:

In biology - 15 questions, 5 of which will be questions on logical thinking. For each correct answer, 3.1 points are awarded, for a total of 46.5 points.

Chemistry - 15 questions. For each correct answer, 3.1 points are awarded, for a total of 46.5 points.

In English - 10 questions. For each correct answer, 1.1 points are awarded, in the amount of 11 points.

In total, a maximum of 104 points are awarded in biology, chemistry and English.

When submitting documents to established specialized schools, benefits apply to students in grades 9-10-11 who took 1-2-3 places at international, regional and main scientific olympiads in mathematics, physics, chemistry, biology, computer science and information technology at the regional level, the list of which is approved by the Agency of Presidential Educational Institutions.

We remind you that the exams were held from 3 to 8 July of the current year (inclusive). Exams were held in 3 shifts - 08:00, 13:00 and 18:00. Examinations in Karakalpakstan were held from 26 to 30 July. Also on August 7, exams were organized for students who could not take part in the exams.

For reference, on April 14, 2022, Decree of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. PF-106 "On expanding the network of specialized schools under the Agency of Presidential Educational Institutions" was adopted. Based on this Decree, 193 specialized schools and boarding schools will be created in the system of the Presidential Agency for Education. 168 of them begin their activities in the 2022-2023 academic year. 23 of these schools are boarding schools that also have dormitories. The remaining 145 specialized schools are designed for home visits.
